14	OTHER LAWFUL PURPOSES.
15	WHEREAS, the governing body of the City of Lithonia, Georgia ("City") is the Mayor
16	and Council thereof; and

17	WHEREAS, the governing authority of the City is authorized by O.C.G.A. § 36-35-3 to
18	adopt ordinances relating to its property, affairs, and local government; and
19	WHEREAS, speeding on Swift Street between the present city limits and Born Street has
20	become a safety hazard to pedestrians and surrounding residents; and
21	WHEREAS, a reduction in traffic speed from thirty-five (35) to twenty-five (25) miles
22	per hour would greatly increase safety to motorists and pedestrians; and
23	WHEREAS, the City desires to increase fines for speed limit violations.
24	THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LITHONIA, GEORGIA HEREBY ORDAINS,
25	AS FOLLOWS:
26	SECTION 1: That the City Council is authorized to reduce the posted speed limit on

27	Swift Street between the present city limits and Born Street from thirty-five (35) to twenty-five
28	(25) miles per hour by adopting the provisions set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto and made a

30	SECTION 2: That the signage reflecting the above speed limit reduction shall be			
31	updated by the Dep	partment of Public Works within thirty (30) days of the adoption of this		
32	Ordinance.			
33	SECTION 3: That the City Council is authorized to increase fines for violations of the City's			
34	speed limit by adopting the provisions set forth below:

- 78 Section 5-1510. Speed limits.
- Twenty-five miles per hour shall be the maximum speed for vehicles being operated within the city limits, except as follows:

81

- 82 a. In parks, fifteen miles per hour.
- 83 b. On streets adjoining school property, during school days, twenty miles per hour.
- on College Avenue from Randall Avenue to and including the intersection with Stone Mountain Street, during school days, twenty miles per hour.
- 86 d. At railroad grade crossings for railroad trains fifteen miles per hour.
- e. On Swift Street between the present city limits and Born Street, Main Street between the city limits and Johnson Street, Rock Chapel Road between the city limits and Church Street, Stone Mountain Street between the city limits and Ida Street, thirty-five miles per hour.
- On streets so designated and marked by the Chief of Police, such maximum speeds as are 91 e. f. reasonable and proper, but not to exceed twenty thirty-five miles per hour, and not less 92 than five miles per hour, as determined by the Chief of Police upon the basis of 93 engineering and traffic surveys, taking into consideration and having due regard that such 94 speeds shall be a safe rate of speed but yet expedite the flow of traffic, and also 95 considering the amount and type of traffic, surface, contour, intersections and width of 96 the street, and any other similar conditions affecting traffic. A public record of such 97 maximum and minimum speed designations, carefully indexed, shall be maintained at all 98 times in the office of the City Clerk and Chief of Police, and the certificate of the Chief 99 of Police bearing the approval of the Mayor to such speed shall be deemed the maximum 100 and minimum speed on such street. 101
- 102 f. g. On streets adjoining property used for religious services, during the regular hours of worship, twenty miles per hour.
